Take Rt 46 East over Hackensack River bridge to Ridgefield Pk. Take first right exit after bridge. Bear right and continue under bridge to Main St. Make left onto Main St. Continue on Main St to Mt Vernon St. Make right onto Mt. Vernon. Parish Center will be on left.


Old Times Having Fun Together
