Henry was raised in Teaneck. He graduated Cum Laude from Fairleigh Dickenson College in 1952, where he also met his wife Helen and were married for 58 years. He was a WWII veteran of the US ARMY, having served in Korea. He was a member of the Teaneck Fire Department, and a Charter Member of the Box 54 Club, Teaneck. Henry worked for the Bergen Record for 37 years as a Photo Editor, Aviation Writer/ Editor, and Copy Editor. He was also Vice President of the Aviation Space Writers Association. He was a Volunteer Fireman in the Little Ferry Fire Department, Hook and Ladder Company #1. He was the Battalion Chief, and served as Fire Chief in 1975. He was also a member and Trustee of the NY/NJ Volunteer Fireman's Asso-

ciation, and member of the Fire Chief's Association. Henry was a member of the VFW Post #809, Little Ferry and a member of the First United Methodist Church, Ridgefield Park, NJ.
