At the last Executive Board meeting it was brought up, by the financial Secretary, that a lot of members have paid anywhere from 15 to 19 years of dues and then stopped. A member needs 20 years of paid up dues to become a Life member. If you think that you are close to that point and have not paid any dues in a while you can do the following. MEMBER BENEFITS UPDATE

- 1. A death benefit currently of \$1,000
- 2. Eligible to apply for higher education scholarships. 12 scholarships are currently awarded annually. You must be a personal member to apply or endorse an application for a scholarship (spouse, child, dependent).
- 3. Ability to attend meetings where information of timely importance is discussed and participating by voting at meetings and the annual convention. A meal is usually served at the conclusion of each meeting.
- 4. Each personal member receives a copy of our association newsletter, The Signal mailed to their home or by email, if requested.
- 5. Participation in the tuition discount program (15%) for Colorado Technical University

These benefits are for personal and life members only. After 20 years as a personal member you become a life member. Life members do not have to pay dues.

Other activities of the NJ & NY Volunteer Firemen's Association include:

- 1. Valor Awards program
- 2. 2 Training scholarships annually for FDs to use the Bergenfield Fire Training Center for live fire training
- 3. Gift card program for families that are burned out. These are delivered in conjunction with the local FD so that the good will generated extends to the local FD as well as the NJ & NY Volunteer Firemen's Association.
- 4. Free training programs sponsored by the association for the benefit of local FDs.
- 5. Conducts an annual memorial service to remember those firefighters that have passed away in the previous year. A Memorial Certificate is presented to the family of each deceased firefighter and a Memorial Wreath is placed at the monument (located at the Bergen County Fire Academy that is owned and maintained by the NJ & NY Volunteer Firemen's Association).
- 6. Maintains a very robust web site that contains valuable information, both training and social, for the fire service

I am strongly encouraging you to have every one of your FD members join as personal members of the New Jersey and New York Volunteer Firemen's Association. Convention Delegates do not qualify for the above benefits but may apply for membership while a Delegate.

Annual dues are a mere \$10.

- 3) The candidate of this award may be nominated by a Chief Officer of any member Department, by a vote of the Department itself or by vote of any organized Ladies' Auxiliary.
- 4) It is recognized that the Ladies' Auxiliaries, by virtue of their main reason for being to support their Fire Department do not receive the publicity they deserve. The filled in application may not have any particular newspaper clippings to refer to their service, but clippings of a fire and other written anecdotal references to other events may be submitted.
