NJNY 2020 UNIT CITATION AWARD

The 2020 NJNY unit citation award is presented to the Rockland Lake Fire Department for mountain rescue of an injured hiker.

On Friday May 22, 2020 at 22:17 the Rockland Lake Fire Department was dispatched for a report of an injured hiker on the mountain plateau at the rear of the fire station. The firefighters ascended the trail and proceeded to the plateau area approximately 1200 feet up from the fire house, after locating the male victim he was found to be 20 feet down from the ledge with serious injuries. Due to weather conditions and the location of the victim Rockland County Technical Rescue Team and Valley Cottage Fire Department were dispatched to aid in stabilization and removal of the injured party. When the TRT team leader arrived on scene he requested Nyack & Piermont FD high angle rescue team, Congers and West Nyack FD and the Westchester County TRT team be dispatched to the scene due to the unstable terrain and safety of the rescuers and the victim descending the mountain with only the use of hand lights. Due to weather conditions no helicopters were flying so they could not get any lighting assistance from overhead. The young victim was safely removed and transported to Westchester Medical Center at 02:01 on Saturday May 23, 2020 by VCAV Ambulance.

The fire department put all equipment away and returned to fire station at 03:38 on Saturday May 23, 2020.

Unfortunately, the recruit died five days later.

The sad note to this unfortunate event is that the recruit was not enrolled as a member of the New Jersey State Firemen's Association. As such, his family will receive no burial benefit. If he had been enrolled his family would have receive a \$36,000 benefit.

Every new firefighter that joins you fire department should immediately be signed up as a member in the New Jersey State Firemen's Association. There should be no delay. No Excuses. Chiefs, local relief secretaries, and all officers should double check their membership rosters to confirm that everyone of your members is either a qualified member (completed 84 months and has been issued a certificate indicating they are a qualified member) or is on the membership report that was just completed and submitted to the state office.
